OPERATION: Sack Lunch can tailor volunteer opportunities to your schedule. We offer short term, partial day, engaging work for small to medium sized groups. We can also offer regularly scheduled, daily, weekly, or annual volunteer opportunities.

### Overview:

- Volunteer hours are normally between 9am-7pm, Mon–Fri, hours are flexible
- Additional volunteer opportunities are available from 2pm-7pm Thurs-Mon
- Our kitchen is in the Compass Center (210 Alaskan Way S.), meal times noon-1pm & 5:30pm-6:30pm
- Our outdoor meal site is at 6<sup>th</sup> & Columbia, meal times 1pm-2pm
- Volunteers under the age of 18 will require an additional sign up form and a supervising adult

We suggest that volunteers wear clean, comfortable clothes and shoes. You will be on your feet! Be sure to layer clothing in the winter, as it will be hot in the kitchen and cold outside. Hair will need to be pulled back; hairnets are available for anyone who's hair is too long to be uncovered and too short to be pulled back securely. In respect of those with allergies, please do not wear strong perfumes or colognes. Jewelry is not allowed on hands or arms unless gloves are worn while handling/preparing any food. In the case of polished or artificial nails, gloves must also be worn while handling/preparing food.
